### Guidelines for Duty Personnel - Please read the full section in the Club Handbook

In order to successfully and safely run sailing at KGSC the following duties must be covered.

It is the OOD's (Officer of the Day) responsibility to ensure that: -

- **All duty personnel are suitably dressed to go in the water if needed at all times of year – including the OOD**
- That radios are issued and tested for Patrol Boats, galley, PRO (Principle Race Officer) and OOD
- Launch tender and recover a minimum of 1 dory which will act as patrol boat cover. Patrol boats must have a minimum crew of 2 during all but the lightest weather
- Make ready and man the truck.
- Assist the Race Officer during the race.
- Open and staff the bar during lunch break and after sailing.

Patrol Boat Crew 1 and 2 as well as primarily acting as Patrol should also be available to do the following duties: -

- Maintain watch on and offer appropriate assistance to all water users, dinghy and windsurfers, at all times during Duty Hours
- Mark laying and positioning for the PRO.
- Ferrying the PRO and his team.
- Taking refreshments to the PRO
- Assist the PRO and OOD in their duties
